STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

SCHOLARSHIP AND FEE CONCESSIONS:

Several types of scholarships of both Central and State Governments such as Post-metric scholarships, SC/ST scholarship, Defence scholarship, etc. can be availed by the eligible students. They are also eligible to get institutional scholarships like Students cash prize, Students Aid Fund, Endowment Cash prizes, Alumni Cash Prizes etc.

Library:

The college has an independent, spacious library with varied and rare collection of more than 30,445 books and various periodicals, journals and news papers on its shelves. All the meritorious and poor students are provided (under PSL) with a set of books for the academic year. An award is given to Best library user in accordance with the Library Committee selection.

Computer Lab:

The college has a well equipped computer lab. There is sufficient number of computers with higher end configuration, embedded with latest Software's and operating systems. There is free Central Internet Network facility for the students.

Gymkhana and Sports:

The gymkhana department provides facilities in the field of sports. It has Basket Ball Court, multi-gym, table tennis as well as indoor games facilities. The Sportsmen are personally supervised and coached by the qualified and experienced Physical Education Director and by Sports experts. The sports achievers are provided with diet and incentives and are encouraged to participate in Inter collegiate, State and National level tournaments. Yearly Zonal Tournaments for various sports are organized.

Canteen facility:

A beautiful canteen is situated on the first floor of the college building. It provides Healthy and Tasty food items at minimum cost.

Youth Red Cross & Scouts and Guides:

These Units are established to promote health, to understand and shoulder civic responsibilities, to develop spirit of service and duty towards society.

N.S.S Units:

Two N.S.S. units of the college with a capacity to enroll 100 volunteers each, provides ample opportunities and experiences to the students to involve themselves in various community oriented programmes. The NSS annual camps are arranged during the mid-term vacations.

Career Guidance & Placement Cell:

The students are guided and trained to face competitive exams.

Campus drives are organized in collaboration with various NGOs and the students are made aware of the job fairs arranged in the nearby places.

Students Grievance Redressal Cell, Anti Ragging Cell and Committee against Sexual Harassment:

These cell authorities keep constant vigilance to maintain healthy atmosphere in the college premises and attend to the grievances of the students and staff whenever they occur. The Grievors can submit their grievances either directly to the cell authorities or drop them in the suggestion boxes kept in the office and library.

Health Care Unit:

A qualified doctor is appointed for students and Staff health care.

Purified drinking water facility is also provided.

Parents Teachers Association:

The association meets twice in an academic year with an objective of further improvement of quality of education imparted.

Alumni Association:

The association meets twice in a year and it constantly works and guides for the student supportive activities.

Students Council:

The student's activities comprise of Gymkhana and Cultural activities. Two Students from each class are nominated as the representatives on the basis of marks scored in the previous examination.

Code of Conduct:

1. 75% attendance to the classes is compulsory, otherwise such students will not be allowed to appear for their annual exams.
2. Wearing of Uniform with chest card and carrying of identity card, is must.
3. Students indulging in indiscipline activities like damaging college property, bringing outsiders to the college is strictly prohibited.
4. Acts leading to communal disharmony, discrimination among students on the basis caste, creed, economic levels is strictly prohibited.
5. Ragging and sexual harassment is a serious punishable offence.
6. Eco-friendly environment maintenance is the duty of the student.
7. Students availing fee concession facility must be prepared to pay entire fees at the end of academic year if the grant from the Government is not received.
8. Gymkhana facility is provided between 12.00 noon and 4.00 p.m.
9. Use of Cell Phones is strictly prohibited in the college premises.

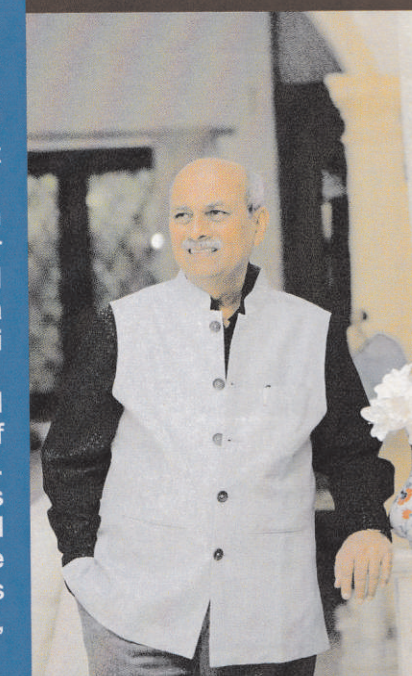

The K.L.E. Society was established by selfless and dedicated service of seven teachers revered as "Saptarshis", namely Shri P. R. Chikodi, Shri S. S. Basavanal, Shri V. V. Patil, Shri B. B. Mamadapur, Shri M. R. Sakhare, Shri B. S. Hanchinal, and Shri H.F.Kattimani. They had the vision to uplift the downtrodden and the illiterate. At that time, a majority of people in North Karnataka had no access to the formal education. The seven dedicated visionaries determined to eradicate illiteracy by starting an educational institution. Their efforts were further nourished and nurtured by the founder members Shri. Rao Bahadur, Shri. R. C. Aratal, Shri Sardar V. G. Naik of Chachadi and Shri Rao Bahadur V. A. Anigol. The generous contributions of Sardar Raja Lakhamagouda Saradesai of Wantamuri, Shri Lingaraj Sardesai of Shirasangi and Shri B.V.Bhoomaraddi and many others, laid a strong foundation to the society.

The sacred sacrifices, selfless efforts and perennial zeal of these committed visionaries resulted in the genesis of the K. L. E. Society in the year 1916. The emblem of the society lays special emphasis on the principles of Truth, Love, Service and Sacrifice. To start with, these visionaries established Anglo-Vernacular School (later renamed as Gilaganchi-Aratal School) at Belagavi. In due course of time several educational institutions were added to make it a gigantic educational institution in the whole of the country. Now the K. L. E. Society has more than 256 institutions under its fold. It is running educational institutions rising from Kinder Garden to Post-Graduation in Arts, Commerce, Science, Management, Agriculture, and Technical & Medical fields.
