STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

SCHOLARSHIP AND FEE CONCESSIONS:

Several types of scholarships of both Central and State Governments such as Post-metric scholarships, SC/ST scholarship, Defence scholarship, etc. can be availed by the eligible students.
